JULY 2010 FIELD DAY REPORT

It was a blustery, showery but occasionally sunny Saturday afternoon that saw 3 beachcombers brave the elements at the Mindarie Quay ready to participate in the inaugural Beachcombers Field Day. The reasons for abandoning Cervantés for a more local venue were that many of the Beachcombers were still away overseas or spread far and wide across this large state meaning that only two of us would make it to the original venue; the weather was not looking particularly fishable for that bit of coast and the lure of sleeping in our own beds in such conditions made the change of location much more attractive.
